Staff discussed an initial resolution (resolution 20-055) to issue up to \$30,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds for UPH Butterfly Gardens, LP, (Butterfly Gardens Apartments), City of Clovis, County of Fresno.

Staff discussed an initial resolution (resolution 20-056) to issue up to \$35,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds for RG 5th Street PSH LP, (5th St. PSH Apartments), City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles.
