  - a. Imperial VI, LP, (Imperial Portfolio), Cities of Calexico, Seeley, Holtville, Brawley, County of Imperial; issue up to \$18,000,000 in multifamily revenue bonds. (Resolution 19-001)
  - b. Mercy Housing California 84, L.P., (Bennett House Apartments), Town of Fairfax, County of Marin; issue up to \$30,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds. (Resolution 19-002)
  - c. Cypress Village CIC, LP, (Salerno Apartments), City of Irvine, County of Orange; issue up to \$30,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds. (Resolution 19-003)
