Executive Director, Edward Becker attended. Lee McCormick, Ben Barker and Travis Cooper of Sierra Management Group L.L.C. attended as financial advisors to the Authority. Ron Lee, of Jones Hall, APLC, attended as counsel to the Authority.

Staff discussed a final resolution (resolution 19-039) to issue up to \$18,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds for Broadway Plaza Family Apartments, LP (Hotel Fresno Apartments), City of Fresno, County of Fresno.

Motion by De Foor; Seconded by Moreno; Motion carries by unanimous vote, without abstentions.

Staff discussed a resolution (resolution 19-040) to approve authorizing amendments of the transfer restrictions and other provisions relating to the CMFA's 2007 debt obligations for Calipatria Family Apartments, located in the City of Calipatria, County of Imperial.
