In attendance virtually for the Authority's meeting were Board Members Bob Adams, Paula Connors, Joya De Foor, as a voting member, Justin McCarthy, and Faye Watanabe, comprising a quorum. Paula Connors served as chair. The meeting was called to order.

John Stoecker, Lee McCormick, Ben Barker, Anthony Stubbs, and Travis Cooper, of Sierra Management Group, LLC attended virtually as financial advisors to the Authority. Katrina Dair and Alexis Tudor of Sierra Management Group, LLC attended virtually. Ron Lee and Brian Haroldson, of Jones Hall, APLC, attended virtually as counsel to the Authority.

The minutes of the meeting(s) of the Board on March 5, 2021 were discussed and approved. Motion by Watanabe; Seconded by Adams; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved an initial resolution (resolution 21-077) to issue up to \$27,000,000 in tax-exempt revenue bonds for C&C Development Co., LLC, or an affiliate, (Pacific Wind Apartments), City of

Carlsbad, County of San Diego.

Motion by De Foor; Seconded by Watanabe; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved an initial resolution (resolution 21-078) to issue up to \$50,000,000 in tax-exempt revenue bonds for Maudelle Shirek, L.P., (Maudelle Miller Shirek Community Apartments), City of Berkeley, County of Alameda.

Motion by Adams; Seconded by McCarthy; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved an initial resolution (resolution 21-079) to issue up to \$40,000,000 in tax-exempt revenue bonds for 7th & Campbell, L.P., (7th & Campbell Apartments), City of Oakland, County of Alameda

Motion by Watanabe; Seconded by De Foor; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved a final resolution (resolution 21-080) to issue up to \$28,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds for UPH Butterfly Gardens, LP, (Butterfly Gardens Apartments), City of Clovis, County of Fresno.

The Board approved a final resolution (resolution 21-081) to issue up to \$40,000,000 in a tax-exempt loan for St. Francis High School, City of Mountain View, County of Santa Clara.

Motion by Watanabe; Seconded by De Foor; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved a final resolution (resolution 21-082) to issue up to \$15,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds for CRP St. Stephen's Apartments LP; (St. Stephens Retirement Center Apartments), City of San Diego, County of San Diego.

Motion by Watanabe; Seconded by De Foor; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

A public hearing was opened regarding the formation, bond issuance and appropriation limits for proposed California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities District 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson) and Future Annexation Areas, and improvement areas therein.

The public hearing was closed.

The Board approved a resolution (resolution 21-085) forming the California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities District No. 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson).

Motion by Adams; Seconded by McCarthy; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved a resolution (resolution 21-086) determining necessity to incur bonded indebtedness and other debt up to \$2,460,000 in and for the California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities District No. 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson).

Motion by De Foor; Seconded by McCarthy; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

The Board approved a resolution (resolution 21-087) calling a special election in and for California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities District No. 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson). Motion by Watanabe; Seconded by Adams; Motion carries unanimously by a roll call vote, without abstentions.

Secretary Bob Adams announced the results of the election. Results of the election were unanimously in favor of CFD formation for California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities District No. 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson).

The Board approved a resolution (resolution 21-088) declaring results of a special election and directing recording of notice of special tax lien in and for each improvement area in California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities Districts No. 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson). First reading of the Ordinance (ordinance 21-05) was waived, levying special taxes within California Municipal Finance Authority Community Facilities District No. 2021-5 (City of Lincoln – Greyson).
