  - a. Canoga Ave, LP and Topanga Canyon, LP, each a California limited partnership, and entities related thereto, (Residence on Canoga & Topanga Apartments), City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles; issue up to \$150,000,000 in multifamily housing revenue bonds. (Resolution 22-325)

b. Palomar Health, a California Health Care District, (Palomar Medical Center), Cities of Escondido, Poway and San Diego, County of San Diego; issue up to \$280,000,000 in tax-exempt and/or taxable revenue bonds. (Resolution 22-326)
